This revision replaces the bulletin of the same number issued on April 11, 1986. The content has been revised to reflect updated information.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bulletin is to make certain that all elementary school administrators and teachers are aware of the procedures governing the use of the catchers mask during physical education, noon, and recess time.

II. PROCEDURES

- A. For the safety of students, each school must keep on hand a quantity of catchers masks sufficient to supply one for each activity area where a catcher is behind a batter, as required in the Elementary Physical Education Teaching Guide, Grades 3-6, Office of Elementary Instruction, Publication No. EC-580, 1986, pp. 287-99.
- B. Each student who is positioned as the catcher must at all times wear the mask while he or she is behind a batter who is holding a bat.
- C. The teacher in charge of the softball activity will assist the catcher with the adjustment of the mask for proper fit.
- D. Schools may order catchers masks from the Catalog of Standard Supplies for Schools and Offices.
